Health System Enhancement Project (HSEP) funded by the Asian Development Bank (ADB) is engaged in four Provinces of Sri Lanka (Central, North Central, Sabaragamuwa, and Uva) to improve efficiency, equity, and responsiveness of the primary health care (PHC) system based on the concept of providing universal health coverage in objective to achieve sustainable development goals and continuum of quality essential health services.

Under the capacity development program, Training on Infection Prevention has been identified as one of the key areas to be strengthened in health security along with many other supportive activities.

Applications are invited from Infection Prevention Nursing Officers of relevant cluster hospitals (Apex and other hospitals) for a short training program in a selected regional country (Singapore)

Qualification Criteria

1. Should hold a permanent post in the government service as a Nursing Officer with a basic training on Infection Prevention and Control.
2. Should be less than 55 years of age.
3. Should be an Infection Prevention and Control Nurse at the relevant Apex Hospitals.
4. Should have worked at least 2 years in a Cluster Hospital attending to infection prevention activities. (Thambutthegama, Medirigiriya, Bibile, Welimada, Kahawatta, Karawanella, Dambulla, Theldeniya and Rikillagaskada clusters)
5. Good understanding and communication skills of the English Language, since all the training would be conducted in the English Language.
6. He /She should actively participate in cluster activities during the past 2 years.
7. He /She should not have participated in foreign training programs conducted by the Health System Enhancement Project under any other category.
8. On return should be able to share the acquired knowledge and skills with the officers of the cluster hospitals under the supervision of the relevant Microbiologists.
9. Should not have any ongoing disciplinary procedures.
10. Tri-party MOU has to be signed with the Provincial Health Department and the Project to provide services with acquired knowledge and skills.
